**Description of Bond Duties**

**Group A**

**Perform one of the following**

**Coach:** Responsible for teaching the players the rules and skills for participation in the game of soccer. Set up necessary practice times and adhere to game schedules. Responsible for proper player and parental participation before, during and after games. Choose team parents to assist in fund raising or for help when rescheduling practice or games. Coaches must apply in writing and are selected by the Tarkill Soccer Club Board. One (1) per team.

**Asst. Coach:** Assists the coach with the above listed responsibilities, as well as taking charge of the team in the coach's absence. Must attend and participate in practices and games. Asst. Coaches will be selected by the Coach of the team and must be approved by the Tarkill Soccer Club Board. Two (2) per team

**Team Parent:** Helps coaches with calling players for any rescheduling of games or practices. Also Distributes and collects any fund raising material that is being handled by the club. Two (2) per team.

**Snack Stand Committee:** Responsible for the scheduling, staffing and supply ordering for the snack stands available to the club. If sign up for Snack Stand, you are on the committee. You must attend the Snack Stand Committee Meetings and work the Snack Stands to be eligible for your bond. Season long position. No limit

**Group B**

**Perform 5 occurrences of the following bond duties:**

**Tryouts:** Help board members and coaches during the club's tryout session. Such as signing in children as they arrive, giving them their designated numbers, organize the children into their age groups. Each tryout session is one occurrence.

**Field Maintenance:** Assist with the maintenance of the fields, particularly, lining the fields for the weekend's games and repairing the goal nets. You will be scheduled in advance and assigned a certain field. This will also include initial field setup and post season take down, which includes goal assembly and field layout

**Goal Setup/removal:** Assist with setting up the goals before the first game of the day and/or remove the goals after the last game of the day.
